Health and Safety

We know that health and safety is so important to every member of our community. To keep it simple, we want you to know that these are the primary ways we will be keeping each other safe during Covid:

1. Until guidance changes, everyone who enters our building will wear a mask while they are here (aside from eating and drinking). No exceptions.
2. All school staff will be vaccinated (by state order)
3. We will keep track of who spent time together so we are prepared to test or keep folks home who may have been in contact with the virus.
4. We will use small class sizes to limit opportunity for virus transmission.
5. We will provide outdoor dining options and small group settings for mealtime.
