Creekside Community High School is accredited and all courses meet the requirements for the Oregon Diploma and college preparation. These courses are **not NCAA approved** and should not be taken by student athletes who are planning to participate in collegiate level athletics. Computer and internet access are the student and family responsibility.

# CCHS Summer School

## General Summer Information

- Summer School courses are available 24 hours a day 7 days a week, Monday July 6th through Thursday July 30th. Courses will no longer be available after July 30th at midnight. **There will be no extensions.**
- Courses are designed to meet the specific needs of individual students; however, due to the nature of the online curriculum, the curriculum cannot be modified. CCHS teachers are available to provide academic support, but case management of IEPs is not available during the summer session.
- Creekside Community High School is accredited and all courses meet the requirements for the Oregon Diploma and college preparation. These courses are not NCAA approved and should not be taken by student athletes who are planning to participate in collegiate athletics.
- Teacher support is available Monday through Thursday from 10am – 2pm. Not all subject support is available during all hours. Because of mandated restrictions due to COVID-19, our building will not be open for in person study. Students must have internet and computer access.
- **Students must register on or before June 26th.** Late registration will not be accepted due to the short nature of the Summer School Program.
- There are no refunds, even if a student does not finish a course.

## Eligibility and Course Selection

- Students must currently be enrolled in a TTSD high school and need to retake a course for grade/skill improvement or credit. These classes are not designed for original credit.
- *All summer school participants should consult with his/her school counselor prior to enrolling at CCHS for Summer School.* Counselors can help students select appropriate courses.
- Students may only take two courses at a time. Students who finish early may add courses on or before July 17th. Courses will not be added after July 17th.
- CCHS staff **strongly discourages** students from attempting to complete both the A and B parts of a course in the short summer school term.

## Student Responsibilities

- Earning a semester credit (0.5 credit) in four weeks is not a task to be taken lightly. It will require a significant time commitment. Time online varies for each student, depending on the previous level of engagement with course content. *Students can expect to spend 15 to 20 hours per week on each course.*

## Registration Process:

1. **Communicate with your Counselor** to determine which course(s) to take.
2. **Complete the Online Registration form** before 4pm on June 26th.
3. **Pay for Courses by June 29th:**
  - Pay Online via TTSD Web Store with debit or credit card\* *Directions on CCHS website.*
  - Mail Check\*\* to 8040 SW Durham Rd, Tigard, Oregon 97224
  - If you are unable to pay by debit/credit card or check, please call 503-431-5820 to make alternate arrangements.
4. **Receive confirmation of enrollment and log in information** via email by July 6th.

\* \$2 convenience fee applies to online payments.

\*\*All checks should be made out to Tigard-Tualatin School District and include the students full name and student ID number in the memo area. Checks must be received by June 29th to be processed.
