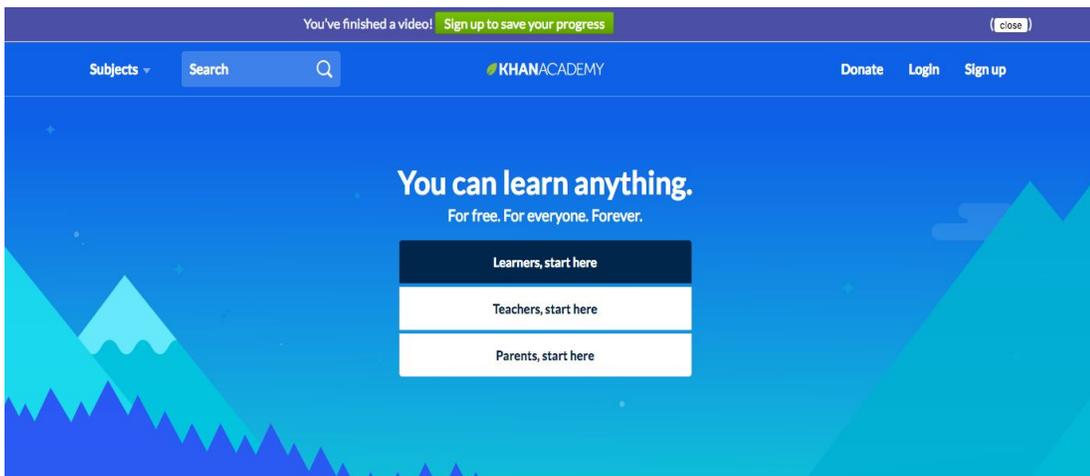


Khan Academy

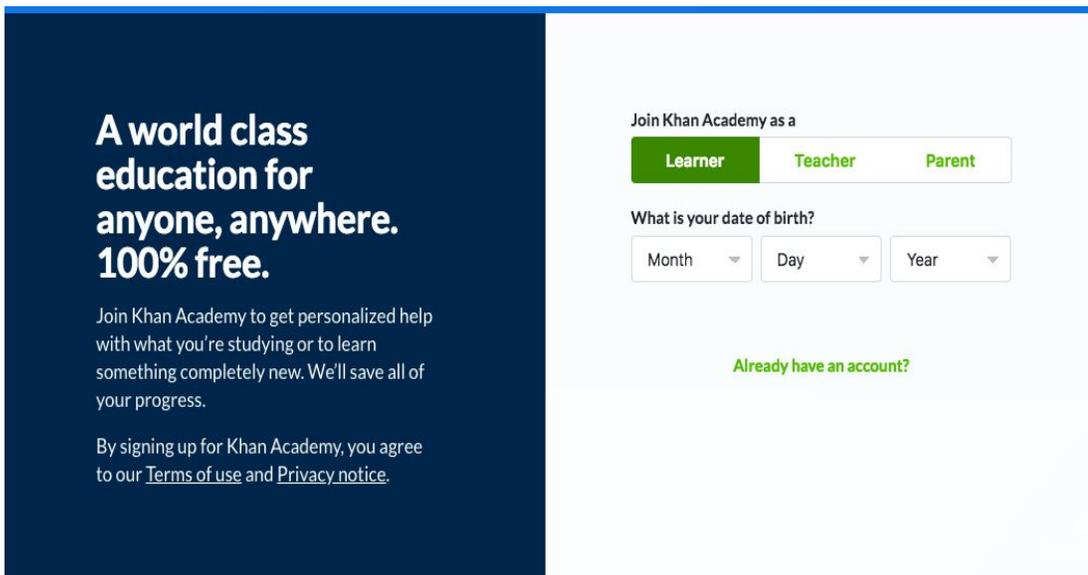
Khan Academy is a non-profit educational organization created in 2006 by educator Salman Khan with a goal of creating a set of online tools that help educate students. The organization produces short lessons in the form of YouTube videos. Its website also includes supplementary practice exercises and materials for students. All resources are available to users of the website. The website and its content are provided mainly in English, but the content is also available in other languages (Spanish, Russian, Turkish, French, Bengali, Hindi, and German).

Login Instructions:

- 1) Go to the website: www.khanacademy.org. Click “sign up” in the upper right-hand corner.



- 2) Create an account. Click “learner” and enter your birthdate (yours or your child’s)
* students under 13 will need to verify an adult knows they are signing up. If the adult does not verify from their email, the account will be closed.



- 3) Add a user name as well as a password. If your birthdate is under 13, you will also need to add a parent email.
- 4) Click on 6th grade content to get a head start on next year or 5th grade to review.
 - a. Note: You can add as many sections as you wish.

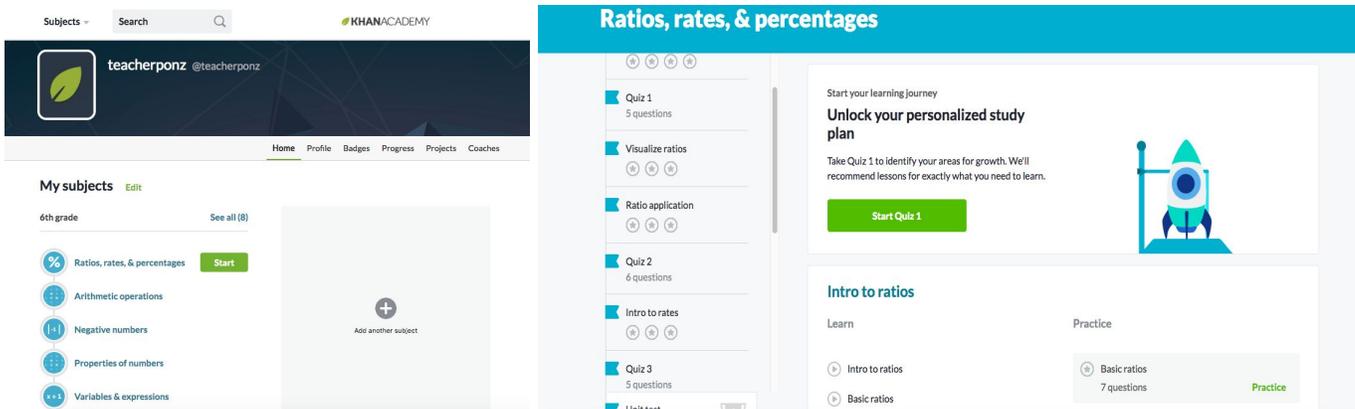
