TAG Parental Rights

Parents of students identified as Talented and Gifted are afforded the following rights as outlined in the following Oregon Administrative Rules:

581-022-2325 (identification)

581-022-2330 (parents' rights)

581-022-2500 (services)

What does Oregon law say about parental rights?

1. Parent permission is required for any individual testing that may need to be administered for identification purposes.
2. If a student is not identified as TAG, a parent has the right to appeal the results.
3. When a student is identified as TAG, the district must inform the parents about the available programs and services.
4. Parents must be provided an opportunity to give input and discuss with the district the programs and services available to their child.
5. Parents may request withdrawal from TAG services and programs at any time.
6. Parents must be informed of their right to file a complaint.
