If you have visited Tualatin High School recently you may have noticed that construction has begun on the new multi purpose sports field. We are excited to share an update on the upcoming bond work which will increase our total classroom count and includes:

- New centralized Administration Office and public entrance on the south side of the building
- Expansion of existing Career Technical Education (CTE) / STEM facilities to include a MakerSpace
- Expansion of the Commons / Cafeteria to provide additional student seating capacity
- Improvements to both the Mens' & Womens' PE / Athletic Facilities including renovation of the Locker and Team Rooms and the addition of a new Fitness Room
- New Special Education classrooms and offices
- New Turfed Multipurpose Sports Field

On the path to the groundbreaking ceremony on June 6th, here are some recent project milestones:

- A solicitation for a General Contractor / Construction Manager has been advertised, a selection will be made in May
- Drawings have been submitted to City of Tualatin to secure permitting
- Several rounds of Focus Group meetings were held in Winter / Spring to refine the design of Athletics, Physical Education, CTE / Electives, Special Education, Academics, Counseling and Administration spaces
- Construction phasing conversations have occurred to determine how work will be timed to achieve minimal disruption to class offerings, students and staff
