

PSAT

The PSAT is a standardized test targeting 10th and 11th graders across the U.S. and is a practice test for the SAT. The PSAT also serves as a qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship Program wherein scores determine students' eligibility for National Merit scholarships. This is an optional test, however college bound Juniors and Sophomores are encouraged to take the test.

When: Saturday, October 16, 2021

Cost: \$35 – Pay and Register with the Bookkeeper

Practice Booklet: Practice booklets will be delivered to students the first week of October

Check-In Time: 7:30 AM in the Commons
* Must have student ID with you at check-in

Testing Time: Begins promptly at 8:00 AM and will end at Noon
* Bring two #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)
* A scientific or graphing calculator is recommended
* No food or drink will be allowed in the classrooms
* No cell phones, Smart watches, iPads, etc., are allowed and may not be used as calculators
