- **Attention All Students driving to school. You must have a Parking Permit to park in the student gravel lot and student parking on 92nd. Students are not allowed to park in the staff lots and tennis courts. Violators will be subject to warning, and Boot Fee. Do not park in neighborhoods that require permits. You could end up with a ticket from Tigard Police!**
