Study Area:

Hall Boulevard from Durham Road to Locust Street

## Purpose

Hall Boulevard is a key transportation corridor in the City of Tigard. It is used by drivers, pedestrians, bus riders, and people on bikes to travel around and through the city. We know that Hall Boulevard's bike lanes, sidewalks, pedestrian crossings can be different along the road in the City of Tigard, so we'd like to hear from you about your experience using the road.

The City of Tigard has started a corridor planning project to decide on the types of improvements that should be made to this roadway. This project is part of a larger effort to get important funding that would help transfer ownership of the road from the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) to the City of Tigard.

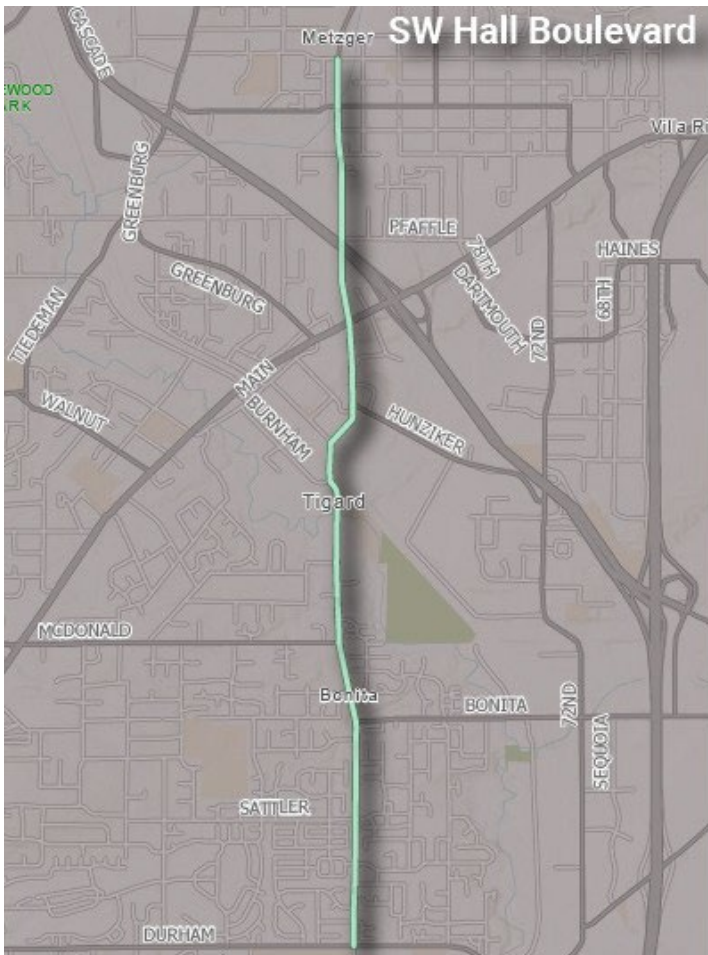
