

## Welcome to the Tigard High School Band program

Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to (or back to) the THS Band program. The purpose of this letter is to let you know what is coming your way for the next school year. We are an extremely active group both at school and in the community. It is important that you check the band website and calendar **weekly** for updates. It can be overwhelming at times, but stick with it, come to our events, and ask questions.

We use Charms Office for much of our administrative processes, so we will be verifying your contact information several times this fall. See the attached letter regarding the Charms login. Please login and verify/update your information, both student and parent.

Not all students participate in every event throughout the year, so it is vital for you to know what the expectations and obligations are. ### GENERAL INFORMATION

Students will perform in a variety of activities: concert performances in December, March, May, and June; assemblies, football and basketball games, Homecoming Parade, Starlight Parade, and Graduation.. All events are/will be posted on the Band Calendar of Events. Any changes will be posted on the calendar and through Charms.

Students also support the program by working at our various required fundraising events: Garage Sale, Craft Fair, Rhythmfest, Can Drives, and the optional yet always fun Balloon Festival.

**If you need to rent a school instrument, email me to see what is available** The rental fee for the year is \$150 (payable to THS Band). If you require a second instrument, the fee for the second instrument will be \$100.

**All Percussionists** (in class, Marching Band, Winter Drumline) will pay the \$150 instrument rental fee on the first day of camp or class. **Rental fee checks are made out to "THS Band" and given to Mr. Irving.**

All students in the program pay a support fee to the Band Boosters. [www.tigardhighbandboosters.com](http://www.tigardhighbandboosters.com) The fee helps pay for festivals, contests, instructors, music, instrument repair, uniforms, transportation and cheese. **A fee coupon is attached or can be downloaded from the Band Website.**

**All Fall fees must be paid by Sept. 27, 2019. All Winter fees must be paid by Jan. 24, 2020.**

### COMPETITIVE MARCHING BAND & COLORGUARD STUDENTS

The Competitive Marching Band (field show) camp starts on **Wednesday, August 14**, from 8:30am-5pm. Evening rehearsals will be Mondays and Wednesdays from 5-9pm beginning August 26th. If you know someone who is interested in our band program that has not signed up, please encourage them to contact Kati McKee.

**All Percussion players (Pit & Battery) will pay the \$150 instrument rental fee on the first day of camp. Rental fee checks are made out to "THS Band" and given to Mr. Irving.**

### CONCERT/ SYMPHONIC BAND, WIND ENSEMBLE, PERCUSSION TECHNIQUES, JAZZ LAB

Your camp is Thursday August 22, 1-3pm and Friday, August 23, 1pm-5pm. You will be learning a great deal of music and preparing for a variety of performances (see General Information).

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The following music must be **memorized** by Aug 22th. : Star Spangled Banner, Fight Song, Celebration, Everybody's Everything (Karate), Eye of the Tiger, Gimme Some Lovin, which are all in the Pep Packets. Note: All students that do not own marching shoes will need to purchase them. Cost is \$40.

Gloves will also need to be purchased at \$4 per pair.
